
Lindenwood has awarded the Boy Scouts of America over \$250,000 in scholarships for the upcoming school year to recognize outstanding youth. The three levels of scholarships range from \$5,000 to \$12,000 per year, or \$20,000 to \$48,000 (excluding an allotted \$2,400 earned in the work and learn program) over a four-year period. Please find the attached scholarship information sheet that explains the criteria and application process for each scholarship.

With its main campus in St. Charles, Missouri, Lindenwood is a four-year co-educational, liberal arts university. Much like the Boy Scouts of America, Lindenwood promotes the importance of a value-oriented culture and education for all of its students. Lindenwood houses more than 3,500 residential students and educates nearly 15,000 total students each academic year; Lindenwood University is the fastest growing institution of higher learning in Missouri.

## BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Lindenwood University and the Boy Scouts of America have announced a scholarship program for those Scouts and Friends of Scouting wishing to pursue a college education and possibly a career in scouting. Varying scholarship levels depend upon achievement with the Boy Scouts and motivation to pursue a career in scouting. A minimum of ten (10) total scholarships will be awarded to begin in the upcoming academic year. These scholarships are competitive; each application will be evaluated by a review committee. Below are the criteria for all scholarships:

**The candidate must:**

- a) have been involved with the Boy Scouts.
- b) include a letter of recommendation from a Boy Scout staff person or adult volunteer leader.
- c) meet University admissions requirements.
- d) apply (and remain continuously enrolled) as a full-time, semester, under graduate resident student in good academic and social standing.
- e) complete a financial aid application to assess eligibility for federal and/or state grants. Any additional outside grants and scholarships will first replace the Lindenwood University scholarship. Any additional institutional aid must be approved by the Dean of Admissions and Financial Aid.
- f) be a new undergraduate, resident student for the upcoming academic year (not necessarily a freshman) not previously contacted by Lindenwood.

**Scout Youth of the Year Award:**

One \$12,400 scholarship, plus an additional \$2,400 Work and Learn Award\*, renewable up to four years, for completion of an undergraduate degree, totaling \$59,200.

**Additional Criteria:**

- a) Candidate must be an Eagle Scout.
- b) Candidate must be recommended by the review board and the Boy Scouts as a recipient for this scholarship.
- c) Candidate must apply (and remain continuously enrolled) as a full-time, undergraduate, residential student.

**Venture Explorer of the Year Award:**

\$6,000 scholarship plus an additional \$2,400 Work and Learn\*, renewable up to four years for completion of an undergraduate degree for a total of \$33,600.

**Additional Criteria:**

- a) Candidate must be an explorer post or venture crew member
- b) Candidate must be recommended by the review board and the Boy Scouts as a recipient for this scholarship.
- c) Candidate must apply (and remain continuously enrolled) as a full-time, undergraduate, residential student.

**Future Scout Leader Award:**

\$6,000 scholarship plus an additional \$2,400 Work and Learn\*, renewable up to four years for completion of an undergraduate degree for a total of \$33,600.

**Additional Criteria:**

- a) Candidate must enroll in the Human Service Agency Management program in hopes to become a Boy Scout or nonprofit sector professional
- b) Candidate must have been involved in one or more of the following:  
-Summer Camp staff -Order of the Arrow -Explorer Post -Venture Crew -Junior Leader Training Camp

**Eagle Award/Venturing Silver Award:**

\$6,000 scholarship plus an additional \$2,400 Work and Learn\*, renewable up to four years for completion of an undergraduate degree for a total of \$33,600.

**Additional Criteria:**

- a) Candidate must be an Eagle Scout or venturing Silver Award.
- \*Work and Learn Award available to residents only.
