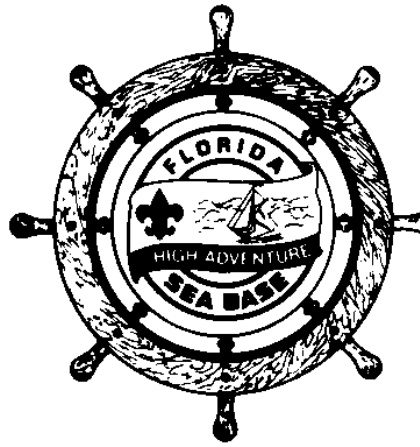

The national Venturing Division invites you to participate in a Venturing Administration course just for volunteers. The course will open your eyes to the unlimited potential in Venturing! You will receive detailed information on how to administer Venturing at the district and council levels. Subjects will include how to conduct crew open house training, new crew organization, serving special markets like religious organizations, Sea Scouting, how to make Venturing advancement pop, Venturing training, Venturing leadership development, how to plan and run exciting activities for teens, teen camping, how to get the expansive Venturing resources, how to keep your crews alive and well, and much more!

When? March 3-7, 2008. The course will begin at 5:00 p.m. on Monday, March 3rd and conclude by 10:30 am on Friday, March 7th. Some may choose to arrive the previous weekend to enjoy the Keys and take advantage of lower airfares. If you do, you will need to contact the Sea Base conference manager to arrange for early arrival. Expect a 2 hour drive from Miami International airport or 2 ½ hours from Ft. Lauderdale International. Classes each day will conclude at 3:30 p.m. so you will have plenty of free time to enjoy the Sea Base and surrounding Keys! Conference attire is casual.

Cost? \$350. Includes housing for four nights and course materials. However the fee does not include airfare or airport transportation. You are responsible for making your own airline and rental car reservations.

Bonus! While the volunteer Venturing Administration course is going on, there will be a concurrent Venturing administration course for professionals, so invite your pros to join you. Then you and your pros can do some valuable strategic planning to grow and support Venturing.
